## **Planes**

Sailplane classes: 15m and standard FAI class sailplanes are accredited.

The maximum wing loading is limited to 50kg/m<sup>2</sup>

## **Entries**

Registration:

The pilot registration Form will be available soon on [www.grandprix-stmoritz.com](http://www.grandprix-stmoritz.com).

Number of entries:

The number of entries for the Sailplane Grand Prix St.Moritz 2010 is limited to a maximum of 15 pilots. If at the preliminary closing date there are more international entries than allocated, priority will be given according to the IGC ranking List.

## **Pilot criteria**

According the SGP rules, pilots:

- Must have flown at least 250 hours as a pilot in command, of which at least 100 hours must be flown in sailplanes.
- Must hold a pilot License or equivalent document issued or recognized by the swiss authorities. (For the validation we will offer support)
- Must hold a current FAI sporting licence.
- Additional, pilots must be experienced in mountainous regions.

## **Entry fee**

Entry fee will be 150€ for each participating pilot and covers all operational costs, except aero tows.

## **Competition Area and Airspace**

The race tasks during the Sailplane Grand Prix St.Moritz, will take place in the Engadin and its surrounding area. The task setting shall achieve, that the race can be observed from the airfield and the mountainous platforms in the Engadin. The task setting will be done under consideration of outlanding possibilities and save terrain clearance.

Fortunately there are no Airspace restrictions for the time during the grand prix. This means, Airspace E and G are available up to Flight Level 130 (3950m/AMSL) or 150 (4550m/AMSL), depending on military activities.

## **Local procedures**

The local procedures will be published on the competition website.

## **Insurance requirements**

- Third party liability insurance, not excluding competitions, conformant to the Luftfahrtverordnung LFV (Art. 125 und 135) or equivalent. (1'500'000 SDR up to a MTOW 999kg)
- Personal medical insurance is required for all pilots, covering accidents and sickness, including any local hospital costs and the costs of transport back to the team member's home country.

## **Aero tows**

Per launch, a maximum of 50 € or less will be charged, depending on weather conditions.

## **Contest numbers and visible markings**

For safety reasons, all planes must be equipped with high visible markings.

Concerning the contest numbers, there are no additional requirements to the SGP rules.

## **Accommodation**

The new camping site, next to the airfield will be available for competitors, crews and visitors. Moreover there are numerous hotels, guest houses and holiday apartments located in the town centre of Samedan (Distance <1km)

There are two restaurants located at the Engadin Airport which will provide you with breakfast buffet and lunch menu for reduced prices.

## **Internet at the Site**

Free wireless internet access will be provided at the aerodrome buildings. LAN connections are available at the press centre and the competitor's common room.
